Premio Alkan 2023, Mayaka Nakagawa è tra i giovani talenti più apprezzati oggi, presenta un programma da Rameau ai giorni nostri.

Born in 1993 in Aichi, Japan, Mayaka Nakagawa began her piano study at the age of 6. She won numerous prizes in domestic and international piano competitions: PTNA Piano Competition (Finalist and Student Jury Special Prize at Grade Superior in 2013 and Silver Prize as well as Oji Hall Special Award at Grade Superior in 2014), the 3rd Prize at Tokyo College of Music Piano Competition, the 1st Prize at FAZIOLI online piano competition, and the 1st Prize at Campillos International Piano Competition. International Chopin Piano Competition in Asia (Gold Prize at High School Category and Bronze Prize at Professional Category), Gold Prize at the 1st Ishikawa International Piano Competition, and 17th International Fryderyk Chopin Piano Competition 2nd stage diploma. Especially, her performance of Prokofiev's 2nd Piano Concerto at the Final of PTNA Piano Competition in 2014 with Japan Philharmonic Orchestra was highly acclaimed by the jury members including prestigious international professors. She has played in many recitals and been invited as a guest pianist throughout Japan such as Tokyo, Nagoya, Nagano, Osaka, Kawasaki, Kobe and Poland (Warsaw, Naleczow, Krakow).

She graduated from Tokyo College of Music as a Special Selected Scholarship Student, and she currently studies at the International Imola Piano Academy in Italy with M. Leonid Margarius. She is also a Special Scholarship Student of Yamaha Music Foundation from 2014.
